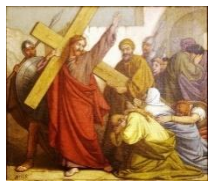

We'd like to update you upon some wonderful, but challenging news for St. Mary Catholic School. Because of your faithful support, Saint Mary School continues to thrive and show a steady increasing enrollment. Mrs. Bormann and her team are honored to announce the projected enrollment for the 2025-26 school year is expected to be just over 200 students.

In order to accommodate our current and incoming students within our facilities, Saint Mary School Board, along with the Parish Finance Council, have agreed to proceed with a second section of kindergarten for the 2025-26 school year.

In the coming weeks, a team involving Saint Mary School and Parish Finance will be exploring options for additional classroom space within our school building. While we consider adjustments within our school, there may be a need to make use of some space in the parish center for a temporary classroom.

Moving forward, in addition to adherence to the board's enrollment protocol, Saint Mary School will be implementing restrictions on our class sizes beginning with our Rising Stars (3 yr. old) and Shining Stars (4 yr. old) preschool classes.

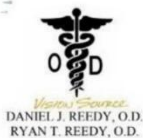
