
Day of Prayer and Reflection - April 20, 2024

A few photo and video reminders to ensure reverence to Jesus in the Eucharist:

- -So that the faithful can focus on worship: no photography or videography during Masses.
- -This includes First Eucharist, Confirmation, Vigil Mass, Weddings (professional photography and videography is allowed during weddings if done discreetly and in communication with the presider)
- -photographs from pews can be taken during the exit procession if done in an unobtrusive manner
- -photographs outside of Mass during a Sacrament like Baptism can be taken if done in an unobtrusive manner and from the pew
- -Photographs outside of Mass can be taken so long as...
- *reverence to Jesus in the Eucharist is respected
- *photos are taken on the side of the altar or elsewhere throughout the church and not taken directly in front of the altar
