

As the current school year comes to a close, we would like to extend our sincerest gratitude for the support shown to Saint Mary School. We are blessed to have the steadfast support of parents, grandparents, and the entirety of St. Mary Parish.

As the summer months settle in, we are diligently preparing for the 2025-26 school year. As was mentioned in previous communication, over the past few years, St. Mary School has experienced a steady and increasing enrollment. We currently have projected enrollment of over 200 students for the 2025-2026 school year and a waiting list for our early childhood classes.

Iowa March for Life June 21

All are invited to the Saturday, June 21 Iowa March for Life in Des Moines. The Iowa March for Life is an opportunity to proclaim the value of all human life at all stages and advocate for the protection of life in our law. The event begins at noon at the Iowa State Capitol Rotunda with educational booths and music. A rally follows at 1 p.m. in the rotunda, then the March for Life will begin at 1:45 p.m. on the grounds. Participants will march around the capitol and supreme court buildings. The capitol is at 1007 East Grand Avenue. Pro-life leaders and state legislators have been invited to participate.
