-So that the faithful can focus on worship: no photography or videography during Masses. -This includes First Eucharist, Confirmation, Vigil Mass, Weddings (professional photography and videography is allowed during weddings if done discreetly and in communication with the presider) -photographs from pews can be taken during the exit procession if done in an unobtrusive manner -photographs outside of Mass during a Sacrament like Baptism can be taken if done in an unobtrusive manner and from the pew

-Photographs outside of Mass can be taken so long as... *reverence to Jesus in the Eucharist is respected *photos are taken on the side of the altar or elsewhere throughout the church and not taken directly in front of the altar



Guest Speaker: Marion Amberg
